<p>Joseph Smith prays in the woods near his home. Visited by God the Father and Jesus Christ. Asks which church he should join. The Savior tells him that they are all wrong and he should join none of them</p>	<p>Joseph Smith Jr born in Sharon, Windsor County, Vermont, the fifth child of eleven in the family of Joseph Smith Sr and Lucy Mack Smith</p>
<p>Joseph Smith's oldest brother Alvin dies</p>	<p>Angel Moroni appears to Joseph Smith three times in his room and one time in the field. He tells him of the Lord's work on the earth in the last days and of the Book of Mormon.</p>
<p>Joseph marries Emma Hale of Harmony Pennsylvania. They are married in the Smith home at Bainbridge, New York</p>	<p>The Lord prepares Joseph Smith to obtain the golden plates</p>
<p>Joseph begins translating the gold plates Emma Smith was the first to help as scribe. Martin Harris, John Whitmer and Oliver Cowdery served as scribes as well.</p>	<p>Joseph obtains the golden plates from Angel Moroni</p>

<p>Apostles Peter, James and John restore the Melchezedck Priesthood</p>	<p>John the Baptist restores the Aaronic Priesthood. Joseph Smith and Oliver Codery baptize on another in the Susquehanna River and ordained each other to the Aaronic Priesthood.</p>
<p>The first 5,000 copies of the Book of Mormon were published at the Grandin Press, Palmyra, New York. 8 pages were type set and then the 5000 pages were printed at a time, then they were hung to dry. 8 pages were then typeset and printed on the reverse side making 16 pages per type set page.</p>	<p>Translation of the Book of Mormon is completed at the Peter Whitmer Sr home in Fayette Township, New York.</p>
<p>Joseph Smith and Oliver Cowdrey organize the Church of Jesus Christ at the home of Peter Whitmer Sr in Fayette, New York with 6 members.</p>	<p>The first printed copies of the Book of Mormon became available. Each copy sold for \$1.75 ( this is equal to about \$24 today).</p>
<p>Independence, Jackson County, Missouri, was the promised location of the city of Zion and the “center place” for the gathering of the saints.</p>	<p>Samuel Smith serves as the church's first formal missionary</p>

<p>Zions Camp departs for Missouri to bring relief to the saints expelled from Jackson County, Missouri</p>	<p>Saints begin fleeing from mobs in Jackson County, Missouri, across the Missouri River and into Clay County.</p>
<p>Dedication of the Kirtland Temple</p>	<p>Quorum of the Twelve Apostles organized in Kirtland, Ohio</p>
<p>The name of the church was established by revelation as the Church of Jesus Christ of Latter-Day Saints</p>	<p>Jesus Christ, Moses, Elias and Elijah appeared in succession in the Kirtland Temple and restored priesthood keys required for the dispensation of the fulness of times.</p>
<p>Joseph Smith publicly annouced the doctrine of baptism for the dead</p>	<p>Lilburn Boggs, govenor of Missouri, signed the extermination order callingfor mormons to be exterminated or driven from the state.</p>

Martyrdom of Joseph and Hyrum Smith at Carthage Jail. 200 men with painted faces stormed the jail killing Joseph and his brother Hyrum. John Taylor was shot four times, Willard Richards was unharmed.

Exodus from Nauvoo begins

Brigham Young becomes leader of the church. Brigham speaks to the saints, he has Joseph's expression, his method of reasoning and even the sound of his voice. Joseph's prophetic mantle falls on Brigham

Winter Quarters established, built over 700 homes as a resting place before the saints traveled further west to the Rocky Mountains.

Nauvoo Temple dedicated. Some 5000 members receive their endowment before they are forced to leave Nauvoo.

The saints enter the Salt Lake Valley, Brigham Young states " This is the right place".

Mormon Battalion. During the Mexican – American War 500 mormons had enlisted for one year of service marching almost 2000 miles leaving Council Bluffs, Iowa marching to Pacific Coast, San Diego California.
